

NOTICE OF SERIES
RS FEVA EUROCUP SERIES 2018

Preamble:

The Eurocup Series 2018 consists of seven regattas with points accumulated from each of the constituent regattas. There is no separate entry or fee for the Eurocup Series. Entry into one of the seven constituent regattas will automatically ensure your results get accumulated for the Eurocup Series results. (see point 5 for detailed information on scoring)

The following participating Regattas will form the RS Feva Eurocup Series 2018:

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

1.1 The Organising Authority (OA) for each participating Regatta is the Sailing Club at the relevant venue and it's National RS Feva Class Association. The International RS Feva Class Association will cumulate results for the Eurocup Series.

2. RULES

- 2.1 All the Regattas will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020.
- 2.2 Each Regatta will have its own Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions. This Notice of Series must be read in conjunction with the Notice of Race for each participating Regatta. Sailing Instructions will be available at registration for each Regatta.
- 2.3 For each individual Regatta, the International RS Feva Class Association (IRSFCA) may appoint a Technical Delegate (TD) who will liaise with the local PRO and help to keep RS Feva Race management standards. Any changes to the NoR and SI will be approved by the TD.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with the class rules and World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 3.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and/or supplied by the Organizing Authority.
The following parts of the hulls and sails must be left clear of for the possible display of the supplied advertising:
 - i) the front 1.2m of the bow
 - ii) the mainsail below the bottom batten
 - iii) the front 1m of the boom nearest the mast.

4. SCHEDULE, ENTRY and ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 The Schedule of participating regattas is as above. The Notice of Race for each Regatta will be posted on the relevant Event page of the International RS Feva website: www.rsfeva.org. All entries for participating Regattas are to be made in accordance with the relevant Notice of Race. Regattas are open to all RS Feva sailors in RS Feva boats. Nationals of the nation organizing a Regatta may be subject to home nation rules from either the local national RS Feva Association or the Local National Sailing Federation (World Sailing MNA). There is no entry fee for the series but see each Notice of Race for the entry fee for each Regatta.
- 4.2 Parental Consent forms for any sailors under 18 during a Regatta will need to be completed separately for each Regatta. The forms will be available on site at each Regatta or may be printed off from the relevant event microsites on www.rsfeva.org.
- 4.3 Regatta, where more than 2 countries participated, will be recognized as a Eurocup regatta. Otherwise the regatta will not be scored in the overall ranking of Eurocup.

5. SCORING

- 5.1 The scoring of the Eurocup Series will use a logarithmic point system. Each crew gets a logarithmic number of points calculated by the following formula for each Regatta:
Number of points = $\{\log(\text{number of boats}/\text{result in regatta}) * 1000 + 101\} 1$
- 5.2 DNC in Regatta will equal the 0 logarithmic points.
- 5.3 The overall Eurocup ranking will use the three best results from any of the Regattas. These three results will be summarized and listed downwardly from the crew with the highest number of logarithmic points. (=boat with the highest

number of logarithmic boat will win). If there is a tie, the boat with the higher (=better result) gain of logarithmic points will be listed higher and so on.

- 5.4 For the purpose of series scoring, results will be based on the skipper's performance.
- 5.5. The Eurocup ranking will list just the boats which have competed in more than one Regatta (does not apply for the Eurocup ranking after first Regatta)

6. PRIZES

- 6.1 For the Eurocup Series the first three boats overall will be awarded trophies at the prize giving for the Grand Final Regatta. There may be other prizes. Each Regatta will have its own prizes as per the Notice of Race for that Regatta.

7. INSURANCE

- 7.1 Participants are reminded that there are differing insurance standards across different countries. Please check and arrange appropriate insurance for the relevant Regatta as per the Notice of Race for that Regatta. As a guide only, these seem to be the relevant insurance requirements in each country:
